

Level 1-3 Instructor Requalification Course

Who should attend?

Existing Tetra Level 1-3 Instructors who previously attended the Level 1-3 Instructor Course whose certificate is due to expire within 3 months.

Course Aims

The purpose of this re-certification course is to provide all attendees with the opportunity to demonstrate sufficient knowledge, understanding and competence to enable Tetra to renew their instructor certificate.

Upon successful completion, Tetra will renew their certification for a further 3 years however where competence is not achieved instructors will be required to re-sit the entire 2 day program again.

Pre-requisites:

There will be a requirement for attendees to have their training manual and have delivered a course within the last 6 months.

In advance of the course they will need to prepare at least one classroom presentation and a practical task which will be allocated to them prior to attending the course.

Each attendee must bring their full Tetra Kit. All attendees must be medically fit to work at height.

Completion of a medical statement is mandatory.

Course information:

1-day duration, maximum 6 people.

Materials:

A new instructor guide and fob will be issued to each attendee in replacement for their old manuals.

Course content includes:

- Introduction to the method for re-certification.
- Equipment verification exercise and re-cap on the user inspection process.
- Practical Assessment where each candidate demonstrates their competence in using the Tetra System.
- Completion of a theory test based on the content of their instructor guide.
- Candidate delivery of pre-prepared classroom presentation allocated prior to attending the course.
- Practical Assessment Instructional Competence of each candidate in delivering a practical task allocated to them prior to attending the course.
- Overview of changes and enhancements made within the new training material.

Certification:

Certification & ID Card will be issued upon successful completion of the course and assessments. This will be valid for 3 years from date of course.

All training is designed and delivered to meet BS 8454:2006 code of practice for the delivery of training and education for work at height and rescue.
