

Working at Height Regulations

Who should attend?

This course is aimed at individuals that need a practical understanding of the Work at Height Regulations 2005 (as amended).

Course Aims:

We will cover the legal duties imposed by the Work at Height Regulations 2005, via a step-by-step travel through the regulations.

Pre-requisites:

- No previous experience or qualification required.
- Delegates must be fluent in English.

Course information:

- Outline the law and legal obligations for work at height including a summary coverage of the schedules.
- Brief understanding of the types of equipment outlined within the schedules and the inspection frequency.
- Coverage of the hierarchy contained within the regulations and how it should be implemented.
