

ASBESTOS AWARENESS TRAINING/DUTY TO MANAGE

Who should attend?

This UKATA course is suitable for anyone with responsibility for protecting others who work in non-domestic premises from the risks of ill health caused by asbestos exposure.

What will I learn?

This classroom course is designed to provide delegates with a basic knowledge of asbestos awareness, including the legal requirements and specifically the duty to manage responsibilities contained within Regulation 4.

Additionally, this course will also give candidates the skills and technical knowledge to implement, manage and review appropriate control measures and efficiently and effectively manage any appointed contractors.

Course information:

1 day duration, maximum 12 people.

No prerequisites required.

NB: If the attendee has successfully completed UKATA asbestos awareness training within the last 6 months, the course duration will be reduced to ½ day.

Certification:

UKATA certificate.

Course content includes:

- An overview of the responsibilities as detailed within the Control of Asbestos Regulations.
- An understanding of the requirements for asbestos surveys and the different types.
- Familiarisation with the results of an asbestos survey and how to decipher the information contained within the report.
- An understanding of the need for an asbestos management plan and its use.
- An insight into the types of asbestos containing materials, its usage and where it can be found in premises.
- An understanding of the requirements and competence of asbestos service providers.
- A basic understanding of the process involved in remediation work.
