

ASBESTOS AWARENESS TRAINING

Who should attend?

This UKATA asbestos awareness course is suitable for anyone who could potentially be exposed to, or disturb asbestos containing materials and for individuals that supervise the individuals undertaking such works.

What will I learn?

This classroom course is designed to provide delegates with a basic knowledge of asbestos awareness, the risks and the legal requirements.

Course information:

½ day duration, maximum 15 people.
No prerequisites required.

Certification:

UKATA certificate.

Course content includes:

- An overview of the legal requirements to comply with the Control of Asbestos Regulations.
- An understanding of the health hazards and risks relating to asbestos exposure and what precautions need to be taken.
- An insight into the types of asbestos containing materials, its usage and where it can be found in premises.
- An understanding of the types of asbestos surveys and where they apply.
- Knowledge on where to obtain information on asbestos in premises prior to commencing work.
- The process if suspicious materials are found including what action to take in the event of an emergency.
- A basic understanding of the process involved in remediation work..
