

IOSH MANAGING SAFELY REFRESHER

Who should attend?

IOSH Managing Safely Refresher course is for candidates who are required to refresh their knowledge learned during the Managing Safely course. The latter certificate is valid for three years.

What will I learn?

This course will provide each candidate with a refresher of the Managing Safely course using the “Plan Do Act Check” approach to recap their knowledge. The course uses an interactive case study across the modules with an examination at the end to assess knowledge.
